**RULES AND REGULATIONS** 

# 1. Regulations Overview

- 1.1. The championship is organized and coordinated by VšĮ "Tauras racing", MB "World sim series" and Lithuanian automobile sport federation (LASF).

# 3. Registration

- 1. Anyone from European Union countries can register for the championship.
- 2. The championship requires its participant to be no younger than 14 years old at the time of registration.
- 3. Registration is only allowed on the official championship's platform WorldSimSeries.com
- 4. The championship forbids participation of individuals who previously held the FIA (motorsports federations) and/or (karting federations) racing driver licenses.
- 5. The driver's real name and surname must be used in the registration form. Nicknames are not allowed. Violation of this rule will result in disqualification.
- 6. By registering for the championship, the participants agree that they're personal data is permitted to be shared with the sponsors and partners of the championship, who may use it for the purposes of public relations and marketing.
- 7. Participation in all the rounds of the championship is only allowed to the individuals who are confirmed to be familiar with the championship's regulations.
- 8. The participants who have failed to provide all the required information, or have provided false information, may be disqualified by the decision of the organizer.

## 4. Qualifying

- 1. Qualifying stage participation could be run in two ways, optional to participants:
  - ONLINE, on the <u>worldsimseries.com</u> platform.
  - At sim racing hubs such as "Simuliatorių Akademija"
- The participants who choose to take part in the championship ONLINE, need to use their personal simulator hardware equipment, Assetto Corsa software and <u>WSS app.</u>

- A single qualifying run price of 5 EUR (Five Euro). Payment is taken at WorldSimSeries.com by the electronic payment methods indicated on the page.
- 4. The duration of a single qualifying run is 60 (sixty) minutes.
- 5. The official qualifying result is the average time of 3 (three) fastest, consecutive laps. The result is only considered official if the three laps are completed in a correct manner, without exceeding the track limits or cutting its corners. As soon as the track limits are exceeded in any way, the result is canceled, and the driver must start again from lap 1.
- 6. After the qualifying stage, the championship organizers will personally contact the Top 100 drivers, informing them about the details of semi-finals' participation. This will be done by email, provided by the participant's account.
- 7. The Qualifying will determine the 100 fastest drivers that will be able to take part in the championship Semi-Finals and next rounds free of cost.

## 5. Semi Finals

- 1. Semi-Finals line-up is made up of the TOP 100 (hundred) drivers who reached the fastest average lap times in qualifying. Participants will be split into four divisions according to Qualifying results. (DIV1 1-25; DIV2 26-50; DIV3 51-75; DIV4 76-100)
- 2. Every Division 1 event is streamed on the WEB and TV.
- 3. Semi finals consists of 6 (six) rounds:

Round 1 2021.01.07

Round 2 2021.01.21

Round 3 2021.02.11

Round 4 2021.02.25

Round 5 2021.03.11

Round 6 2021.03.25

- 4. Cars and track will be announced a week before race day
- **5.** The setup of each race is fixed, except for the quantity of fuel and brake balance.
- **6.** Track grip levels and other conditions will be selected randomly and will be announced on a race day.
- **7.** If a driver who has qualified in the Top 100 will not participate in the round, the next driver from Qualifying results will take part in the division.
- 8. Start procedure is standing
- **9.** In case of a "False start", the software will teleport you to the pitlane with a 30s time penalty.
- 10. Car damage is set to be 100%.
- 11. Racing rules Official FIA and WSS platform Esport rules and regulations

- **12.** The racers that finished 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th in the round will be promoted to a higher division for the next event (except for Division 1).
- **13.** The racers that finished 20 and lower (or do not start or do not finish at all) in the Race will be demoted one division lower for the next event (except for Division 4).
- **14.** If the driver will not start in one of the rounds the expected division does not change.
- 15. 5 best race results will be taken to overall standings.
- 16. The Standing page will be updated after every round results approval by the judges.
- **17.** Every driver has a right to protest in 1 (one) hour after the race finishes. "Report Driver" button should be found inside the event result page after the race finishes.
- 18. WSS rating points are counted individually and do not affect championship standings.
- **19.** Racing incidents The racing incident protests will be reviewed by the judges after each race. Time penalties will be imposed after the confirmation of the participant's fault of the racing incident. (+5 seconds), (+15 seconds) or (+30 seconds) will be added to the final result. The penalty size will depend on the damage caused to the appellant during the racing incident and its impact overall to the race.
- **20.** Incident points are calculated depending on crash impact speed ranging 1-2-4 for a single contact.
- **21.** Maximum incident points per race 16.
- **22.** Driver who collects 16 incident points in a race will be automatically banned from a server. If the driver will be banned from the server, participants will be able to join the next round.
- **23.** It is the responsibility of all drivers to not make contacts. Failure to do so will result in incident points for both drivers.

- 25. Every race counts in the overall championship standings.
- **26.** If two or more participants finish the Semi-Finals with the same number of points, the higher place in the Championship standings shall be awarded according to:

- a) Wins b) Podiums c) Started races d) Finished races
- 27. After six rounds of semi-finals, TOP 6 (six) overall standing participants goes to the Finals

## 6. Finals - real life tests

- 1. Participants will be informed in advance about the time and location of the finals.
- 2. All costs for arrival logistics to the final will be covered by the organizers.
- 3. All participant points collected in semi-finals reset to 0 (zero).
- 4. The finals will be evaluated by three stages with different evaluation criteria consisting of:
  - Physical preparation
  - Real driving skill
  - Mental preparation
- 5. The physical evaluation will be run based on a physical training testing program. Participants will be individually evaluated by experts from physical training.
- 6. The driving test will take place in a purpose-built venue, compliant with all the safety requirements. Drivers will use a fully race-prepared vehicle.
- 7. A psychological evaluation will be carried out with a form of test.
- 8. Based on the accumulated results of each test, the contestants will receive points in the following sequence:

## Physical preparation

- 9. The winner and the champion of the Dream 2 Drive championship become the one who will collect the most points after the three final rounds, without violating the regulations of the championship and having met all the requirements of the organizers.
- 10. The final of the championship may be rescheduled due to the COVID situation in Europe, but it will not be canceled.

#### 11. The winner of the championship wins:

- Automobile federation racing license.
- Racing equipment.
- The contract to sign in the Dream 2 Drive driver development program.

## Commitments of contestants

- 1. The contestant taking part in qualifying, semi-final or final rounds must::
- a. Strictly adhere to all the verbal and written instructions from the organizers and event coordinators. Participants who refuse to follow the agreed rules will be asked to leave the venue of the event.
- b. Be in an adequate physical condition and not under the influence of any psychoactive substance. If organizers express their concerns and suspicions about the contestant's physical or mental state, he/she will be asked to leave the venue of the event.
- 2. By registering to the championship, the participants agree that all photographic and video media captured during the event, including material featuring the participants, could be used for the purposes of the championship publicity without any further permission from the participant.
- 3. The winner of the championship must sign the document that confirms the act of collection of the prize.
- 4. The winner of the championship must sign a contract with VšĮ "Tauras racing", which declares all the conditions and requirements of the usage of the prize.
